Key Responsibilities

To enhance skipping coaching capacity across Australia

Specific Duties

- Refine Skipping Australia's *Level 1 Coaching Manual* and develop associated resources to support new clubs and coaches
- Develop a coach certification process, endorsed by Skipping Australia/ Sport Australia, to enhance the development and professionalism of skipping coaching practices
- Support clubs and their coaches to develop and implement plans to address their club-specific coach development requirements (eg professional development, succession planning)
- Develop initiatives that help address clubs' coach development requirements (eg developing/delivering professional development courses, coordinating mentoring sessions)
- Actively contribute to Skipping Australia's efforts to develop new clubs across Australia by support the development and implementation of targeted initiatives (eg Jump Rope demonstration teams)

Desirable Attributes

- highly experienced coach / mentor (in any discipline) or skilled skipper with experience in coaching
- strong interpersonal skills and ability to lead and motivate others
- interest in sourcing, adapting or creating training resources
- strong desire to grow and enhance the professionalism of skipping coaching across Australia
- passion for growing participation in skipping and developing new clubs across Australia
